She revealed that the Government is engaging in a ten year strategic plan of skilling Ugandans and urged Muni University to support this plan because she already saw some great innovations like the clapping method to switch power on and off. The permanent secretary was accompanied by the Commissioner for Higher Education Dr.Robert Odok Oceng who thanked the PS for honoring the invitation. For close to two years, preparations have been on going to receive HE Yoweri Kaguta Museveni to officially commission Muni University and install the first Chancellor of the University and finally on September 12<sup>th</sup> 2016 this long awaited event took place at the University campus at Muni Hill.

The President of the Republic of Uganda

HE. Yoweri Kaguta Museveni officially commissioned Muni University and installed Dr. Eric Adriko as the first Chancellor of Muni University in a ceremony witnessed by hundreds of guests. He congratulated Dr Eric Adriko on being appointed as the first Chancellor of Muni University and said this was a well-deserved appointment based on his academic records.

According to His Excellency, the academic programmes at Muni University are good and

there is sure market for these courses, however he said the next area to go in is engineering. Good enough Dr Eric Adriko is an engineer he recognized that this venture needs infrastructure to which he pledged support saying that the 15 billion UGX yearly appeal for support made by the Vice Chancellor Professor Christine Dranzoa during her speech which the president acknowledged was a good speech, is little money for the government.

His Excellency, the President of the republic of Uganda was accompanied by the first lady also the Minister of Education and Sports Hon Janet Museveni who revealed that the Ministry of Education and Sports is excited

about what has happened here at Muni which is the first Public University in Uganda built from scratch by the Government of Uganda funding without any other funds.

According to the Minister, the model of financing infrastructure should be replicated in other government projects and that the strategic location of Muni University in North Western part of Uganda bordering Congo and Sudan should be able to help our brothers and sisters in the spirit of Pan Africanism and the East African Community. According to the Minister, the University will transform lives beyond the east African region. She appealed to the Management to be good stewards of the University facility as stewardship calls for good maintenance.

Doctor Eric Adriko who was installed by the President as the first Chancellor thanked the Government for their support in establishing a university in West Nile and also for granting him an eternal gift as there will never be any other first chancellor of Muni University, he pledged to serve to the best of his ability to create an enabling environment for innovation. The function was well attended by hundreds of guests including Honorable Members of parliament and Ministers.
