## Muni University to host Uganda-Germany Symposium

Muni University is set to host the Uganda- Germany Investment Symposium that will foresee 800 Guests in attendance,200 from Germany and 600 from within the country and the neighboring South Sudan and DR Congo.

The Symposium organized by Operation Wealth creation (OWC) President's office in partnership with Uganda Investment Authority (UIA), and convened by Gen (Rtd) Caleb Akandwanaho SS "Oriba", Chief Coordinator, OWC President's Office, will run from 24th to 26th July 2019.

The Symposium themed "Transformation through regional integration, investment and infrastructure development—Pan African peace building thru holistic development of Africa's Upper Nile Valley" (N Uganda, NE DRC and S Sudan)". Is among other objectives, aimed at unleashing investment, innovations, commercialization, business development and trade opportunities from Uganda/Africa-Germany/European Union (EU) Academia-Industry/Private Sector-Government Partnerships, and enabling Ugandan/African Private Sector to tap into Germany's €1 Billion Africa Investment Fund announced by German Chancellor Angela Merkel on 30th October 2018
